PRINCIPALS ACTION NEEDED: IDENTIFY COORDINATOR(S)

STRIDE Coordinator:

- Paid (stipend funded by SCUSD) position on each SCUSD elementary school campus.
- Identified by principal, educated/supported by SRA.

WHAT Do They Do?:

- Coordinates on-campus program.
- Direct line of communication with SRA for program management.
- Works with SRA and software partner to upload class rosters and create student badges.
- Identifies running space, schedule and process for movement/running on campus.
- Schedules weekly movement/running opportunities for all 1st-6th graders.
- Scans (and/or assigns assistant scanners) student badges during all movement/running opportunities.
- Syncs scanners to software and distributes data to teachers and administrators.
- Distributes rewards during the school year.
- Manages celebration opportunities throughout the year.
- Works with SRA to coordinate school participation in 6th grade Olympic Day events.

WHO Are They?:

- Potential personnel includes a variety of different campus/community leaders - No prior training needed.
 - Classroom teacher.
 - PE teacher.
 - Noon duty supervisor.
 - After school care worker.
 - Parent.
 - Community member.
 - Shared role.

HOW Should We Choose?:

- Ideal candidate is...
 - Available on campus during school day (PE, lunch recess, etc).
 - Excited about opportunity to build a lasting program.
 - Comfortable with basic software program (which they will be trained in by SRA).

WHY Do You Need to Know Now?:

- SRA's outreach and education starts in August! STRIDE Coordinators will be contacted before academic year starts.
- SRA education seminars for all STRIDE Coordinators will happen in late August/early September.
- STRIDE supplies will be distributed to schools.
- STRIDE will launch on each campus shortly after the education seminars.

EDUCATION Coordinator Training:

- Details will be shared directly with coordinators.
- Returning and new coordinator seminars will be conducted in the fall.
